FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>Loulé Cup is an international event, open to all clubs affiliated in the respective Federations as well as Representatives of National Federations, District or Regional associations.</p>
AGE LIMITS	<p>Individual Trampoline * Double Mini Trampoline * Tumbling U13 – born in 2014 and after 13-14 – born in 2012 or 2013</p>
ENTRY FEES	<p>The cost for the entry fees is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One apparatus: 20€ (twenty euros); • Two apparatus: 30€ (thirty euros); • Three apparatus: 40€ (forty euros). <p>Entries will be considered on a first come first served basis.</p>



EVENT FORMAT	<p>Each gymnast can only participate in one group in each apparatus.</p> <p>Difficulty limits</p> <p>Individual Trampoline U13 and 13-14(Male/Female) – * 10 different technical elements. * 5 elements with minimum 270° somersault.</p> <p>Double Mini Trampoline *13-14 years – One skill must have at least 360° of somersault rotation.</p> <p>Tumbling *U13 – No twisting or salt pass. The last element of all the routines must end with 360° somersault with or without twist *13-14 years – No twisting or salt pass. The last element of all the routines must with a 360° somersault with or without twist.</p> <p>FINALS – Individual The competitors with 8 (eight) best totals of the two executed routines in the qualifying rounds in the different classes, will participate in the final. In the case of less than 8 competitors, all of them will go to the finals. No competitor will go through to the final with a DNS, DNF or DSQ. All Finals starts from zero.</p> <p>TEAM competition Team Competition format will be defined in the Workplan but includes all ages and apparatus.</p>	
	INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the Members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. (For additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges: go to: https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php)</p> <p>The Local Organizing Committee will verify the insurance upon arrival of the Delegation Members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation Members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the Local Organizing Committee in advance.</p>
	SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges, and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>



<p>ACCREDITATION</p>	<p>Delegation accreditation will take place upon arrival. For accreditation, Heads of the Delegations are required to bring the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Passports of all members of the delegation; - Proof of total payments; - Proof of medical insurances. <p>All financial obligations must be fulfilled before arrival or during the accreditation. Accreditation card is personal for each of the delegation members. Accreditation card wearing is required at all times of the tournament.</p>
<p>JUDGES AND JURIES</p>	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet until the end of the event, and in the respective discipline.</p> <p>It is compulsory that the participating Delegations bring 1 (one) judge with FIG judges brevet for every 8 competitors.</p> <p>1-8 = 1 Judge 9-16 = 2 Judges 17-24 = 3 Judges 25 or more = 4 Judges</p> <p>The Clubs, Associations or Federations that present less judges than required by the established rules will be penalized with the payment of a fee of 50€/gymnast (Fifty Euros per gymnast) for each missing judge according to the previous threshold (<u>e.g. if only one FIG judge is indicated for 11 competitors, a fee of 150€ will be due</u>). The non-payment of the penalty will imply the non-participation in the event of the respective competitors. All the judges indicated by the respective Clubs, Associations and Federations to the organization, will have to be present at the respective judges' meetings and must remain available during all competition days. Note that judges penalties will still be due in case judges are either not fully available throughout the three competition days or fail to be present at one of the sessions they are indicated to judge.</p> <p>Note: Transport, accommodation, and meals of the judges of each delegation are of the respective delegations' responsibility.</p>

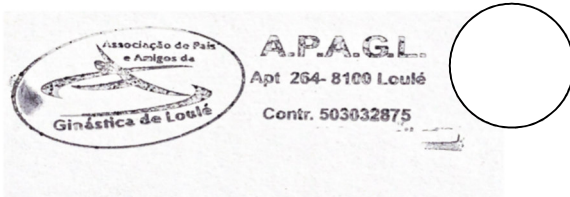
